During the Spring and Fall the Double H opens its doors to a variety of specialty programs and weekend get-a-ways for children and families.

The Double H Ranch was co-founded by Charles R. Wood and Paul Newman and was built under the fundamental principle that no child should be denied the joys of childhood due to an illness or physical limitation, nor should they be restricted due to a family's financial situation.
