JUDGMENT

This case was set for trial this date. Plaintiff appeared in person and through counsel. Defendant did not appear for trial. Plaintiff moved for a default judgment. Motion GRANTED for his failure to appear and defend the case at trial. The Court heard *ore tenus* testimony from George V. Wilde, IV. After considering the pleadings, testimony, and other evidence presented, the Court FINDS in favor of the Plaintiff and against Defendant on his claims for breach of contract and an egregious fraud.

A judgment is entered in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant in the sum of \$514,000.00 (consisting of \$14,000.00 compensatory damages for breach of contract and \$500,000.00 in punitive damages for fraud).

Defendant is also taxed with court costs.
