WHAT:

The Leukemia Cup Regatta® is a thrilling series of sailing events that combines the joy of boating with the important task of raising money to fight leukemia, lymphoma and other blood cancers. Since its inception, The Leukemia Cup Regatta has raised more than \$38 million for research and patient services. The Power Boat Poker Run, started on the Chesapeake Bay is in its 15 year and falls under the Regatta series. We have raised over \$500,000 in the past 14 years of doing this event.

WHO:

All boating enthusiasts or those who like to watch beautiful boats from shore. Anyone with an interest in boating and a passion about raising funds to cure cancer is welcome.

HOW:

Skippers register their boats and recruit their friends and colleagues to help crew and to raise funds. Crew members seek donations from friends, family, co-workers and employers to sponsor their boat. With the help of event participants, The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society (LLS) seeks national and local event sponsors.

WHY:

To benefit LLS's mission: Cure leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease and myeloma, and to provide education and to improve the quality of life for patients and their families.

WHERE:

Promotion and recruitment for 40-plus Leukemia Cup Regattas takes place in many major markets throughout the country. Regatta events take place from January through October. The Power Boat Poker Run has been continuously run for 14 years. It started here and there have been several other Leukemia Poker Runs events across the US. This is the oldest continuously running event.

Our goal this year like the years in the past is to raise money for the Maryland Chapter of The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society of Maryland.
